

Phase 2 Scope

- Items identified in EPDP Team Charter:
 - System for Standardized Access to Non-Public Registration Data
 - Annex to the Temporary Specification (Important Issues for Further Community Action)
- Items deferred from EPDP Team phase 1, either requiring further consideration or dependent on input from others
- No re-chartering envisioned by GNSO Council



Recent Developments (1/2)

- ICANN Board approved the policy recommendations with the exception of parts of recommendation #1 purpose 2 and recommendation #12.
- This initiates as stated in ICANN bylaws a consultation process between Board and GNSO Council.
- GNSO Council scheduled an extraordinary meeting in 28th May to discuss the next steps with regard to non-approved parts.
- EPDP team expressed interest to engage in the process and waiting for next steps and instructions from GNSO Council
- Implementation discussion for phase 1 started with a pre-IRT which converted to proper IRT after board resolution. Registries and Registrars are also required to Implement New Interim Registration Data Policy by 20 May 2019




Recent Developments (2/2)

- Selection of EPDP Team Chair for phase 2, Janis Karklins
- Started deliberations early this month, 90min calls in weekly basis
- ICANN Board already approved initial resources till Marrakech meeting including professional facilitators and legal counsel. EPDP team needs to identify additional resources for post-ICANN65 e.g. face to face meeting.
- Initial focus of work as requested by GNSO Council:
 - Development of work plan and timeline for phase 2 to be reviewed and approved by GNSO Council
- Agreement on approach and working methods to be followed by the team e.g worksheet to outline the scope, modalities, timeline and dependencies, as well as record the progress in deliberations



Proposed timeline phase 2



- Items from priority 2 could be incorporated in the Initial / Final Report for priority 1, depending on their date of completion or presented separately. Decision on reporting format will be taken not later than ICANN 66.
- Use work sheets to map out dependencies and expected timing for priority 2 items
- Finalization of priority 2 items may extend beyond the timeline depicted above as a result of dependencies
