



JOINT DECLARATION
BETWEEN
Japan Network Information Center
AND
National Internet Development Agency of Korea

This Declaration is made as of June 30 2008, by and between Japan Network Information Center (JPNIC), and National Internet Development Agency of Korea (NIDA). In this Declaration, JPNIC and NIDA are referred to individually as a "Party."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties recognize the need of mutual cooperation for stable Internet operation in Asia Pacific region.

WHEREAS, the parties desire to establish the official cooperative framework which is mutually beneficial and acceptable to both parties;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and of mutual promises contained herein, the Parties here to agree as follows:

Article 1 Scope

The Parties agree to jointly identify a possible cooperation in the following areas:

- ▶ Contribute for stable Internet operation as NIR
- ▶ Study on IPv4 exhaustion and measurements
- ▶ Survey on ISP's IPv6 deployment status and issues
- ▶ Exchange strategies and policies to help ISP's IPv6 deployment and so on.

Article 2 Implementation and Additional Agreement

Upon signature of this declaration, the Parties shall do their reasonable endeavours for future possible cooperation based on cross visits and mutual consultations. In addition, the interested parties may enter into a separate agreement on detailed cooperation project, if necessary.

Article 3 Duration

The tasks (as described above) to be carried out by the Parties shall begin from the date of this declaration and shall continue during an initial period of three (3) years unless either Party gives the other Party at least three (3) months prior written notice of its intention to terminate this collaboration.
